

Ensure Accurate Test Results

Follow this four-step process...

- 1. Always inspect ingredients in all foods, medicines and drinks
- 2. Refrain from eating five minutes before testing
- 3. Rinse with water prior to testing
- 4. Ensure proper vehicle ventilation

Hand Sanitizer/ Antibacterial Soaps	Hot Sauces
Mouthwash	Honey Buns
Inhaler	Sugarless Gums (sweetened with sugar alcohol)
Household Products (air fresheners, bleach, dish washing liquid, laundry detergent, glue)	Hygiene Products (deodorant sprays, after shave, perfume/ body sprays, toothpaste, cosmetics, skin applicants, mouthwash, insect repellent)
Windshield Wiper Fluid	Medicines (suppressants, decongestants, antihistamines, sleeping aids, etc)
Energy/Protein Bars/Vitamins	Ripe Fruit
Coffee Drinks/ Energy Drinks	Fermented Soda Drinks
"Alcohol-free" Beer/Wine	Chewing Tobacco/Dip (Fruit Flavors)
Foods (cooked with or containing alcohol)	E-cigarettes
