# North Carolina License Recovery After A DUI



#### STEP 1

Obtain a DL-123 from your auto insurance company or agent. These forms are valid for 30 days, so wait until you are ready to request interlock driving privileges before you request one.

#### STEP 2

Obtain an alcohol assessment at an approved provider. The cost is \$100. Services can be located on the https://www.ncdhhs.gov/website.

## STEP 3

Make an appointment to have your ignition interlock installed by calling Monitech of North Carolina at 800-521-4246. Ask about current discounts and offers.

### STEP 4

If you work non-standard hours, obtain a letter from your employer stating when you need to be at work.

# STEP 5

Fill out an application for Interlock Limited Driving Privilege. This form can be located on the https://www.nccourts.gov/ website.

### STEP 6

Take these documents to the Clerk of Court in the county where you were originally charged. Pay any fees or fines and you will be issued your limited driving privilege.

### STEP 7

Take your copy of the privilege and your vehicle to a local DMV. They will verify that your interlock is installed.
