



North Carolina License Restoration



STEP 1

Obtain a DL-123 Form from your auto insurance company or agent. These forms are only valid for 30 days, so wait until you are ready to request interlock driving privileges before requesting one.



STEP 2

Obtain an alcohol assessment from an approved provider. More information and services can be found on the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS) website (ncdhhs.gov).



STEP 3

Call your State Certified Ignition Interlock Device Expert at (800) 521-4246 to ask about money saving discounts and schedule your Ignition Interlock Device (IID) installation.



STEP 4

Fill out an application for Interlock Limited Driving Privilege, which can be found on the NCDHHS website.

If you work non-standard hours, obtain a letter from your employer stating when you need to be at work.



STEP 5

Take all documents to the Clerk of Court in the county where you were originally charged. Pay any fees and fines to be issued your limited driving privilege.



STEP 6

Take a copy of your Limited Driving Privilege document and your vehicle to your local Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) so they may verify that your IID has been installed.
